He will not escape justice. Donald Trump will become the first former president of the United States to be judged in a criminal trial. It will be on March 25. The former President is accused of having paid \$130,000 to a pornographic actress to conceal an extramarital affair. A New York judge has just rejected Donald Trump's requests to cancel the prosecution. The billionaire denounces electoral interference for the November presidential election.
