The Prime Minister spoke a few days before the opening of the *Salon de l'Agriculture*. He ensures that of the 62 commitments made for the profession, 100 % of projects have begun. A new Egalim bill, which aims to guarantee a minimum income for farmers will be presented by this summer. Gabriel Attal also announced that more than 99% of basic aid from the European Common Agricultural Policy have already been paid. The rest of the aid will be paid by March 15.

Missak Manouchian will be at the Pantheon. Emmanuel Macron will chair a ceremony at the end of the afternoon in honor of the Armenian resistance fighter, who will be laid to rest with his wife Mélinée. Missak Manouchian, survivor of the Armenian genocide and leader of a group of foreign fighters against the Nazi occupation, was executed in February 1944. This is the fourth time that Emmanuel Macron will bring a personality into the Pantheon, after Simone Veil, Maurice Genevoix and Joséphine Baker.

A person died in a shooting last night in Nîmes in a sensitive neighborhood. A car was targeted near a drug sales point. The victim's son was also in the vehicle but was not injured. The area was already the scene of a shooting earlier this month.

A new complaint for rape is filed against Gérard Miller by a 39-year-old woman. The events allegedly occurred when she was 17 and in high school. This complaint against the psychoanalyst is added to those already filed by two other women.

And then soccer with the departure of Thomas Tuchel from the Bayern Munich. The German coach will leave the club at the end of the season. Currently the Baravarois are second in the German championship.
