28 departments are placed under orange weather alert - The vast majority for violent winds as a consequence of the passage of storm Louis. Caution from Pas-de-Calais to the Meuse via the English Channel. Also in the south-west, from the Pyrénées-Atlantiques to Haute-Garonne. Several train lines are suspended, notably in Brittany and Normandy. The railway network invites its users to be careful when traveling.

The return of the big debate. To calm the anger of an entire profession, Emmanuel Macron may inaugurate the Salon de l'Agriculure on Saturday with a big debate. Some 200 people, trade unionists, farmers and associations, are expected.

The French Federation of Toy Industries sounds the alarm regarding Temu, The Chinese online sales platform. 95% of toys sold on this site are dangerous for children. They are not compliant with European safety rules. According to this study, these toys can cause cuts, blockings of the respiratory tract and even suffocation. Faced with this observation, the European and French toy federation are calling on the authorities to take action.

There has been a case of theft of wine bottles in Beaune. A business owner filed a complaint after discovering by video surveillance that his employee was the burglar. During a search more than 7,000 bottles were discovered at his home, he allegedly stole them little by little over the years. The damage exceeds 500,000 euros. The 56-year-old suspect was indicted and will be tried this summer in criminal court.
