Gusts of wind are reaching 135 km/h near Saint-Nazaire, 124 at the top of the Eiffel Tower and 113 at La Roche sur Yon. Storm Louis is sweeping across France. 27 departments are under orange alert, the vast majority due to violent winds. The northern half of the country is mainly concerned but part of the south-west, from the Pyrénées-Atlantiques to Haute-Garonne is also affected. Train traffic is suspended in several regions, notably in Normandy. Météo France calls for caution and specifies that tomorrow only Seine-et-Marne and Deux-Sèvres will remain placed under orange alert for floods.

Will Mahjoub Mahjoubi be deported? The imam of Bagnols-sur-Cèze was arrested. He will be placed in administrative detention, in a center located in the Paris region. In a video relayed on social networks, Mahjoub Mahjoubi, had qualified the French flag of satanic.

Daniel Alves is sentenced to four and a half years in prison. The former PSG soccer player was tried in Barcelona for the rape of a woman in the toilets of a nightclub. Daniel Alves will also have to pay 150,000 euros to the victim. He appealed his conviction.

The American spaceship Odysseus is aiming for the moon, more than 50 years after the end of the Apollo program, an American company will attempt a moon landing today. It would be a first for a private spacecraft. A perilous mission, as the success rate is estimated at less than 50% according to NASA. We will find out if the mission was a success.
