"The conditions for a more peaceful dialogue are not met", says the president of the FNSEA. He refuses the debate wanted tomorrow by Emmanuel Macron for the opening of the *Salon de l'Agriculture*. He considers that the dignity of farmers is tarnished. Several other guests announced that they would not participate, including the *Jeunes Agriculteurs*.

And on the eve of the opening of the Salon, the farmers are hitting hard. Tractors are on the Esplanade des Invalides but also at Porte de Versailles. The FNSEA warns that they will stay up all night until the arrival of Emmanuel Macron for the opening of the Salon. The president of the Salon de l'agriculture expects "animated" exchanges during the visit of the Head of State.

In Deux-Sèvres, *La Morinière* nightclub remains closed. It was there that Erwan, 18 years old, spent the evening two weeks ago before disappearing. He was thrown out of the establishment due to his state of intoxication. The young man's relatives filed a complaint against the nightclub for negligence. The prefecture does not authorize the reopening this weekend to avoid potential incidents.

Germany will legalize the consumption of recreational cannabis from April 1. The German parliament has just given the green light. The text plans to authorize the purchase of cannabis in quantity limited to 25 grams per day through non-profit associations. It will also be possible to grow up to three plants for your own use. This was a flagship bill from the Chancellor Olaf Scholz.

And then the Césars this evening, with two big favorites for this 49th edition. "The Animal Kingdom" and "Anatomy of a Fall". Between them, they represent 23 nominations. Justine Triet, director of Anatomy of a Fall, may become the first woman rewarded for her achievement since Tonie Marshall, 24 years ago.
