Will the Senate give the green light to the inclusion of voluntary termination of pregnancy in the Constitution? Senators will vote on the question today. LR Senator Philippe Bas submitted an amendment which modifies the wording of the bill by removing the notion of "guaranteed freedom" for women to access abortion. This different wording may delay the adoption of the text by Congress.

Another bill could be adopted today, on a European scale this time, and this bill requests a medical examination every 15 years to keep one's driving license. This is a bill drafted by the environmentalist MP Karima Delli, president of the transportation committee. The measure is strongly criticized by the association *40 millions d'automobilistes*, which does not consider it useful. The objective of the measure is to achieve zero deaths on the roads in 2050.

Marine Le Pen is at the Salon de l'Agriculture. The president of the RN at the National Assembly calls for freedom from the obstacles that the European Union imposes on French agriculture. The president of the region Auvergne Rhône-Alpes, Laurent Wauquiez, also visited the Salon. He says he is wary of floor price - An idea defended by Emmanuel Macron.

Was sensitive data on the Paris Olympic Games stolen? A bag containing confidential data was allegedly stolen from a train. The computer and the USB key belonged to an engineer from the Paris town hall. According to the newspaper *Le Parisien*, the investigation was entrusted to the regional transportation police. The president of the organizing committee for the Olympic Games, Tony Estanguet, does not confirm this event.

The funeral of Alexei Navalny will take place on Friday in Moscow. The Russian opponent died ten days ago, at the age of 47, while serving a 19-year prison sentence for extremism. The remains of Alexei Navalny were handed over to his mother a few days ago.

And then will the female French soccer players win the first trophy in their history? The French women's team faces Spain this evening in the final of the Nations League. The Spanish, reigning world champions, are playing at home in Seville. Kick-off 7 p.m.
