925 parliamentarians gathered in Congress at the Palace de Versailles. MPs and senators will vote this afternoon to include abortion in the Constitution. After the green light from Parliament this afternoon, France will become the first country in the world to include in its Constitution the freedom of women to have an abortion.

The inscription in the constitution is far from winning unanimous support. In Rouen, anti-abortionists have been attacking the Simone-Veil IVG center for several days now. The establishment was the victim of hacking on its site, repeated false appointment or even tagging. The founder of the center will file a complaint.

The bill which aims to fight "Fast Fashion" is arriving today at the National Assembly. The phenomenon developed by several websites, notably Chinese, makes it possible to sell a large number of clothes at low price and very poor quality. The text, carried by Horizons MPs, is examined in committee today before debates in the Assembly on March 14. It plans to sanction the sites concerned, with a penalty of 10 euros per article.

He will ultimately remain in Tunisia. The court validated today the extradition of imam Mahjoub Mahjoubi wanted by the Minister of the Interior Gérald Darmanin. The Muslim preacher from Bagnols-sur-Cèze, accused of preaching anti-France beliefs, had filed a summary freedom order to return to French territory, which was therefore rejected by the Paris administrative court.
