Encourage the vocations of local elected officials. This is the objective of this bill examined from today in the Senate. It aims to create a status for mayors and MPs, as resignations are increasing. According to Eric Krezel, mayor of Céfon and vice-president of the Association of Rural Mayors of France, these roles are becoming increasingly difficult to take on.

The Association of Rural Mayors of France also calls for the inclusion of these provisions in the labor code, to facilitate the exercise of a profession in parallel with the function of elected official.
