Last Wednesday, a teacher at the Maurice Ravel high school in the 20th arrondissement of Paris asked a student to remove her headscarf before going to class. Just afterward, the teacher received numerous death threats on social networks. Nicole Belloubet went there this morning. The Minister of Education denounces "unacceptable" threats and promises that the government remains very attentive to what is happening on the online.

Scenes of chaos this morning at the Gustave Eiffel high school in Cachan in Val-de-Marne. Hundreds of students demonstrated to denounce their working conditions in this establishment deemed unsanitary. The demonstration then degenerated. Clashes broke out with the police and a 17-year-old boy was arrested.
