



## Understanding Adjectives in English Grammar

### What are Adjectives?

Adjectives are words that describe or modify nouns. They provide additional information about the noun, such as its size, color, shape, or quality. Adjectives can appear before a noun (attributive position) or after a linking verb (predicative position).

### Explication in French:

Les adjectifs sont des mots qui décrivent ou modifient les noms. Ils fournissent des informations supplémentaires sur le nom, telles que sa taille, sa couleur, sa forme ou sa qualité. Les adjectifs peuvent apparaître avant un nom (position attributive) ou après un verbe de liaison (position prédicative).

### Examples:

- Attributive: She wore a **red** dress.
- Predicative: The sky is **blue**.
- Phrase I am **happy to meet you**

### Common Mistakes

When using adjectives in English, ensure they agree in number and gender with the noun they modify. Additionally, the order of adjectives can be tricky.

Typically, adjectives follow the order: opinion, size, age .. etc ,**for example:**

Correct: She bought a **beautiful small old round blue Italian leather**
