Understanding causative verbs in English Grammar

What are causative verbs?

Causative verbs are used to indicate that one person causes another person to do something. The main causative verbs in English are "make," "have," "get," "let," and "help." Each of these verbs has specific rules for usage.

Explanation in French:

- 3. **Get** (persuade someone to do something)
 - We got him to join the team. (Nous l'avons persuadé de rejoindre l'équipe.)

Common Mistakes:

When using causative verbs, it is crucial to use the correct form of the verb that follows. For instance, "make" and "let" are followed by the base form of the verb, while "get" and "have" are followed by an infinitive or base form depending on the context.

Incorrect: He made her to cry. Correct: He made her cry.
