



# **Understanding Idiomatic Expressions in English**

# What are Idiomatic Expressions?

Idiomatic expressions are phrases or expressions that have a figurative meaning different from the literal meaning of the individual words. These expressions are commonly used in everyday language by native speakers and often do not translate directly across different languages.

### **Explication in french:**

# **Examples of Idiomatic Expressions:**

### 1. Break the ice

Meaning: To initiate conversation in a social setting.

### 2. Hit the nail on the head

*Meaning:* To describe exactly what is causing a situation or problem.

Example: "When Sarah identified the cause of the delay, she hit the nail on the head."

### 3. Let the cat out of the bag

Meaning: To reveal a secret.

Example: "He accidentally let the cat out of the bag about the surprise party."

### 4. Spill the beans

*Meaning:* To disclose information that was supposed to be kept secret.

Example: "She spilled the beans about their vacation plans."

### 5. Piece of cake

Meaning: Something that is very easy to do.

Example: "The exam was a piece of cake for her."

When using idiomatic expressions, it's important to understand their figurative meaning and the context in which they are used. Misusing idioms can lead to confusion or misunderstanding.
