

Understanding the Past Simple tense in English Grammar

What is the past simple tense or preterit?

The Past Simple tense is used to describe actions that happened at a specific time in the past. It is often accompanied by time expressions such as "yesterday," "last week," or "two years ago." Regular verbs in the Past Simple end with "-ed," while irregular verbs have unique past forms.

Explication en french :

Le temps Past Simple est utilisé pour décrire des actions qui se sont produites à un moment spécifique dans le passé. Il est souvent accompagné d'expressions de temps telles que "hier," "la semaine dernière," ou "il y a deux ans." Les verbes réguliers au Past Simple se terminent par "-ed," tandis que les verbes irréguliers ont des formes uniques au passé.

Examples:

- Regular verb: "She walked to the park."
- Irregular verb: "He ate breakfast early."
- We did our homework last night

Common Mistakes

Using incorrect verb forms: Ensure you use the correct past form of irregular verbs. For example, the past form of "go" is "went," not "goed."

Incorrect time expressions: Use appropriate time expressions to indicate the past, such as "yesterday," "last night," or "in 2010."
