



Understanding the Purpose of using purpose clauses

What are purpose clauses?

Purpose clauses are subordinate clauses that indicate the reason or intention behind the action stated in the main clause. They often begin with conjunctions like "so that," "in order that," or "to" followed by an infinitive or a finite verb. Purpose clauses clarify the purpose or goal of the action in the main clause.

Explication in french

Les clauses de but sont des propositions subordonnées qui indiquent la raison ou l'intention derrière l'action énoncée dans la proposition principale. Elles commencent souvent par des conjonctions comme "pour que", "afin que" ou "pour" suivies d'un infinitif ou d'un verbe fini. Les clauses de but clarifient le but ou l'objectif de l'action dans la proposition principale.

Examples:

With infinitive:

Main clause: He works hard

Purpose clause: He works hard to succeed.

With finite verb:

Main clause: She studies diligently

Purpose clause: She studies diligently so that she can pass the exam.

Common mistakes

Using incorrect conjunctions: Using "because" instead of "so that" can change the meaning of the sentence. Exemple She studies hard because to succeed Correct: She studies hard so that she can succeed.

Placing the purpose clause incorrectly can lead to confusion.

Incorrect: He bought new shoes to in order look fashionable.
