



## **Understanding pronouns in English Grammar**

### What are pronouns?

Pronouns are words used to replace nouns in a sentence, making the sentence less repetitive and easier to read. They can represent people, things, places, or ideas. Common types of pronouns include personal pronouns (e.g., he, she, it), possessive pronouns (e.g., his, hers, theirs), reflexive pronouns (e.g., myself, yourself), and demonstrative pronouns (e.g., this, that, these).

### **Explication in French:**

Les pronoms sont des mots utilisés pour remplacer des noms dans une phrase, rendant la phrase moins répétitive et plus facile à lire. Ils peuvent représenter des personnes, des choses, des lieux ou des idées. Les types courants de pronoms incluent les pronoms personnels (par exemple, il, elle), les pronoms possessifs (par exemple, son, sa, leur), les pronoms réfléchis (par exemple, moi-même, toi-même) et les pronoms démonstratifs (par exemple, ceci, cela).

### **Examples:**

### 1. Personal pronouns:

Marie loves her cat. It is very playful.

### 2. Possessive pronouns:

- This book is mine.
- Their house is big.

## 3. Reflexive pronouns:

- She made herself a sandwich.
- They enjoyed themselves at the party.

## 4. Demonstrative pronouns:

• This is my car.

### **Common Mistakes**

Misusing possessive pronouns

Incorrect: The dog hurt it's paw. (It's means "it is")

Correct: The dog hurt its paw.

Using the wrong form of a pronoun:

Incorrect: Me and him went to the store.
