The death of streamer Jean Pormanove was not caused by any third-party intervention. This is the conclusion of the autopsy report which also states that the two forensic doctors did not find any traumatic injuries. The Nice public prosecutor has ordered further tests, including toxicological analyses, to determine the cause of death of the 46-year-old. Jean Pormanove was regularly subjected to physical abuse live on the Kick platform.

The court of appeal in Fort de France has handed a one-year prison sentence to Rodrigue Petitot. The leader of the movement against the high cost of living, the RRPRAC, will be able to serve his sentence at home, wearing an electronic tag. He was tried last June for breaking into a prefectural residence last November. In January, he was given a one-year suspended prison sentence, but the public prosecutor appealed.

As for the hike in US tariffs for the EU, in the end no tax exemption will be made for wine, which will also be taxed at 15%. The news has caused widespread dismay among winegrowers, with France and Italy having been leading the charge in lobbying for the exemption. In addition to the customs duties imposed on European products, the EU has committed to purchasing \$750 billion worth of energy from the United States and making an additional \$600 billion in investments in the country.
