38% of students are considering dropping out of university due to poor mental health. The concerning findings were released today by the body the National Student Mental Health Barometer. The study showed that nearly 6 out of 10 students show signs of psychological distress and that female students were more likely to be concerned, with symptoms such as disrupted sleep and stress.

Two investigations have been opened after yesterday, in the département of Loir-et-Cher, a motorcyclist collided head-on with a heavy goods vehicle and then at his home, police found the body of his wife, who had died due to strangling. The public prosecutor in Blois has put forward the hypothesis of murder followed by suicide.
